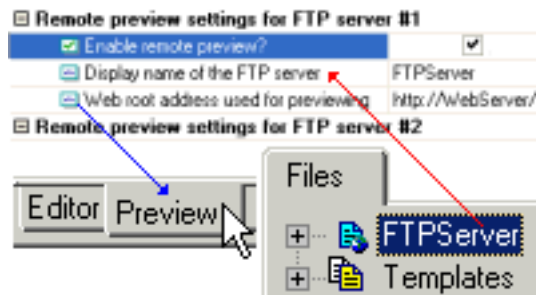

Description

Makes it easier to preview files opened from remote FTP servers through a web server while editing.

Features:

- Previews files opened from remote FTP servers through a web server specified in plugin preferences.
- Ability to maintain up to 3 different web servers for previewing.
- Editor Preview tab or the plugin button can be used to invoke the remote preview.

Usage:

- To assign a web server for previewing remote FTP files: invoke the Preferences dialog using the plugin drop-down menu. Enter the "Display name of the FTP Server" which is the name given to the FTP server in the Workspace (not necessarily the server address, but the name that appears in the Workspace window). Secondly, enter the "Web root address used for previewing" files opened from the FTP server. Finally, check the "Enable remote preview" checkbox and click the "OK" button.
- To preview a remote file through the specified web server: open a file from one of the FTP servers listed under plugin preferences and click the plugin icon.
- To automate the process of previewing remote files through a web server when the Preview tab in the editor window is selected: pick "Edit | Preferences" from the main menu and change to the "Preview" tab. Make sure that the "Enable file mappings" option is checked and click "Edit Preview Rules." Click "Add" under "File extension mappings." Enter a list of extensions of files

that should be previewed through the web server, such as "php;asp;jsp" (without the quotes). Click the "Plugin" radio button and pick "hkRemotePreview" from the drop-down menu. Click "OK" followed by two more "OK" clicks to close the preferences dialog. Now the Preview tab in editor windows will automatically preview the listed file types through the specified web server (inside the Preview window).

Common Questions

Q: How do I install hkRemotePreview?

A: Download the "hkRemotePreview" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: Tools

hkRemotePreview's icon will appear on the "Tools" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Tools" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: hkRemotePreview was written in hkScript. More plugins written in hkScript can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall hkRemotePreview?

A: Right click the hkRemotePreview icon on the Actions

Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
