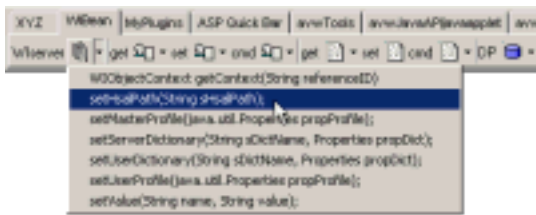

Description

Adds menu options for inserting code snippets related to BusinessObjects WebIntelligence JSP (WI-JSP).

Covers:

- WIServer methods,
- Command and get/set methods in WISession,
- Command and get/set methods in WIDocuments,
- WIDataProviders collection and the WIDataProvider object,
- WIPrompts collection and the WIPrompt object, and
- WIFields collection and the WIField object.

Common Questions

Q: How do I install aaWIBean?

A: Download the "aaWIBean" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: WIBean

aaWIBean's icon will appear on the "WIBean" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | WIBean" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: aaWIBean was written in hkScript. More plugins written in hkScript can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: What's the quickest way to uninstall aaWIBean?

A: Right click the aaWIBean icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
