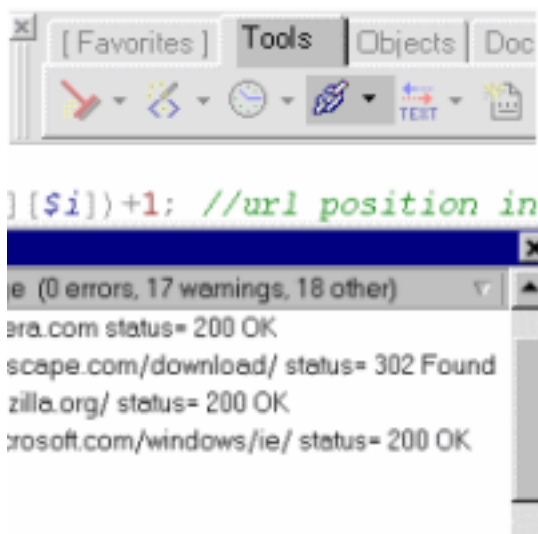

Description

Checks remote links and local relative paths.

Features:

- Checks absolute HTTP and FTP links,
- Checks relative file paths based on the directory of the current file,
- Checks the syntax of email addresses,
- Checks the host of news server addresses, and
- Supports opening web pages using URLs in addition to local file paths.

Requirements

- HTML-Kit Build 292
- Local installation of PHP

Common Questions

Q: How do I install irLinkChecker?

A: Download the "irLinkChecker" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: Tools

irLinkChecker's icon will appear on the "Tools" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Tools" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: irLinkChecker was written in PHP. More plugins written in PHP can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall irLinkChecker?

A: Right click the irLinkChecker icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
