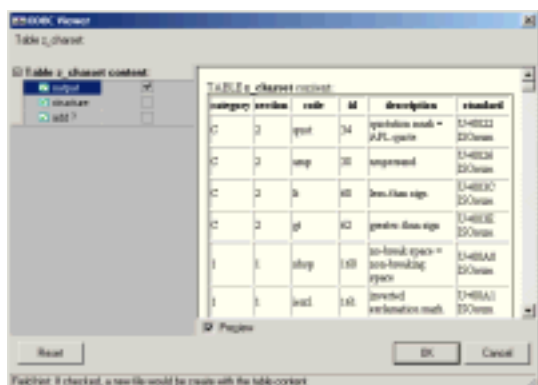

Description

Adds wizard dialogs for performing the following functions on ODBC datasources / tables: connect to an ODBC datasource, list the available tables, view the table structure, view the table content, create HTML tables using the database table content, and optionally add data to the table. NOTE: The author of this PHP plugin has requested that it is listed as a beta version, and is accepting additions to the source code.

Requirements

- HTML-Kit Build 292
- Local installation of PHP
- functioning ODBC datasource (DSN)

Common Questions

Q: How do I install irODBC?

A: Download the "irODBC" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: MyPlugins

irODBC's icon will appear on the "MyPlugins" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | MyPlugins" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: irODBC was written in PHP. More plugins written in PHP can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: What's the quickest way to uninstall irODBC?

A: Right click the irODBC icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
