Description

Generates a report of HTML and accessibility checks while browsing.

Features:

- Checks for HTML and accessibility errors as you browse websites.
- Generates a report of browsed sites.
- Makes it easier to test the final output of script-driven pages.
- Categorized warnings and errors that makes it easier to concentrate on specific types of messages.
- Ability to view the source of errors with a double click.
- Source window for viewing markup in real-time.
- Option for opening the source of the current page in HTML-Kit.
- Status bar with progress indicator.

Usage:

- To start testing a site, enter a website address in the Address field and press Enter. Browse as usual. The test results will appear in the Information window.
- To generate a report of the sites browsed so far, click the Generate Report button on the toolbar.
- To keep the source window in view, hover over the Source tab and click the pin on the top right corner of the Source window.

Common Questions

Q: How do I install hkBrowseAndTest?

A: Download the "hkBrowseAndTest" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: Tools

hkBrowseAndTest's icon will appear on the "Tools" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Tools" sub menu.

Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall hkBrowseAndTest?

A: Right click the hkBrowseAndTest icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
