A: hkpDemos

demoCSPickItem's icon will appear on the "hkpDemos" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | hkpDemos" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: demoCSPickItem was written in C#. More plugins written in C# can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.

Q: Is it necessary to install the .NET Framework and how do I get it?
