Description

Creates a side-by-side preview of the specified HTML document with and without a style sheet.

Features:

- Provides a side-by-side preview of the specified HTML file with and without a style sheet.
- Able to generate a split preview of the current document in the editor, a local file or a remote web page.
- Options for splitting the two views horizontally or vertically.

Usage:

- To preview the current document in the editor: invoke the plugin and click the "OK" button.
- To preview a local file: invoke the plugin and click the folder icon to select a file.
- To preview a remote web page: invoke the plugin and enter the web page address starting with the "http://" prefix.

- HTML-Kit Build 292

Common Questions

Q: How do I install gmSplitCssView?

A: Download the "gmSplitCssView" plugin and save it to a folder of your choice (for example, c:\webfiles\). It's not necessary to manually extract the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the proper folder during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "Open."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: Style

gmSplitCssView's icon will appear on the "Style" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Style" sub menu.

Q: Which programming language was used to write it?

A: gmSplitCssView was written in hkScript. More plugins written in hkScript can be found on the Plugins page.

Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall gmSplitCssView?

A: Right click the gmSplitCssView icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
