

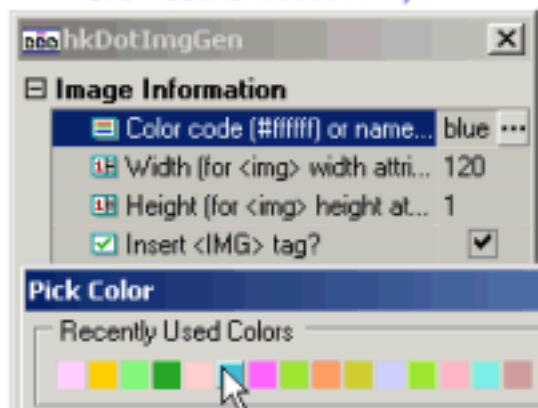

Description

Generates a single-color or transparent image and optionally inserts an IMG tag.

Features:

- Adds a wizard for generating single-color or transparent images.
- Makes it easier to add image-based dots, vertical/horizontal lines/borders/bars, rectangles and transparent space holders to Web pages.
- Color picker for selecting Web-safe or custom colors.
- The color can be specified using a 6-digit hex color code (#0000ff), 3-digit hex color code (#00f) or a common color name (blue).
- Optionally inserts tag with WIDTH, HEIGHT and ALT attributes.

Usage:

- To generate a single-color/transparent image: invoke the plugin, and enter the color, width and height. Optionally enable the "Insert tag" checkbox. Click "OK" to generate the image.

Common Questions

Q: How do I install hkDotImgGen?

A: Download the "hkDotImgGen" plugin and save it to a folder of your choice (for example, c:\webfiles\). It's not necessary to manually extract the *.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the proper folder during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded *.zip file and click "Open."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

Q: How do I run it?

A: Objects

hkDotImgGen's icon will appear on the "Objects" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Objects" sub menu.

Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall hkDotImgGen?

A: Right click the hkDotImgGen icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
