## Description

Converts the selected text to PHP, JavaScript and VBScript print statements.

Supported output formats:

- PHP plain strings, and echo, echo() and print() statements,
- JavaScript plain strings, and document.write() statements, and
- VBScript plain strings, and Response.Write() statements.

Features:

- Indent generated code using spaces or tabs,
- Ability to change the indent width, and
- Add line-breaks before and after the converted strings.

## Common Questions

*Q: How do I install keToScriptStrings?*

A: Download the "keToScriptStrings" plugin. It's not necessary to unzip the \*.zip file, HTML-Kit will expand it to the appropriate directory during the installation.

Select "Install | Install Plugin" from HTML-Kit's "Tools" menu. Point to the downloaded \*.zip file and click "OK."

If any additional prompts appear, follow them to complete the installation.

*Q: How do I run it?*

A: Tools

keToScriptStrings's icon will appear on the "Tools" tab on HTML-Kit's Actions Bar. It can also be invoked from the "Actions | Tools" sub menu.

*Q: Which programming language was used to write it?*

A: keToScriptStrings was written in hkScript. More plugins written in hkScript can be found on the Plugins page.

*Q: Whats' the quickest way to uninstall keToScriptStrings?*

A: Right click the keToScriptStrings icon on the Actions Bar and select "Uninstall." Alternatively, the "Tools | Install | Uninstall Plugins" menu option in HTML-Kit can be used to uninstall this and other plugins.

*Q: Do I need the exact versions of software listed under the Requirements?*

A: The versions listed are the minimum versions required by this plugin. For example, a plugin that requires HTML-Kit Build 290 will run on HTML-Kit Build 292 as well.

*Q: What's the best way to check which version of HTML-Kit I'm using?*

A: The build number can be found on the "About" dialog, which is located on HTML-Kit's "Help" menu.
